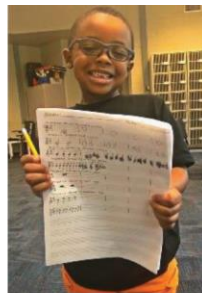

Program Registration Information

- **\$40 Annual Program Membership Fee and Auto-Pay required to register**
This yearly fee of \$40 per family allows you to participate in all Y programs at the Arthur Blank Family Youth YMCA throughout the year.
- **Program Cost:**
 - \$80/week (5 days) – All sites, all schools
 - \$60/week (3 days) – Centennial Academy only *in-person only registration required*
 - Deposit required for all registrations. Auto-draft payments required (*processing fee will be assessed for all manual payments taken*)
- **Scholarships**
As a non-profit organization, the Y provides financial assistance to families in need, enabling them to participate in Y programs. Financial assistance is determined by family income and other factors. The YMCA also accepts 3rd party payments from other organizations that help families in need. The YMCA currently accepts:
 - Division of Family & Children Services (CAPS Certificate)
 - Atlanta Housing Authority (AHA Voucher)
 - Georgia Community Support and Solutions (GCSS)
