TRADITIONAL CAMP

Traditional Day Camp with a weekly theme, swimming, crafts, cooking, STEM, team building, and more.

TRADITIONAL CAMP - NAVIGATORS

Our Navigators Camp combines traditional, leadership, and travel camps. This camp will include three field trips or special events each week.

TRADITIONAL CAMP - LIT (LEADERS IN TRAINING)

Leaders in Training participate in their own camp activities as well as help with camp wide activities. Must have completed LIT classes.

SPECIALTY CAMP - STEM

Campers will spend the mornings in traditional camp activities and the afternoons with hands on STEM activities.

SPECIALTY CAMP - ART

Campers will spend the mornings in traditional camp activities and the afternoons learning about and creating art of different styles and materials.

SPECIALTY CAMP - COOKING

Campers will spend the mornings in traditional camp activities and the afternoons learning about kitchen safety,healthy food choices, cooking, and eating.

SPECIALTY CAMP - GARDENING & AGRICULTURE

Campers will spend the mornings in traditional camp activities and the afternoons in the community garden learning about gardening and agriculture.

SPECIALTY CAMP - DANCE

Campers will spend the mornings in traditional camp activities and the afternoons learning and participating in various dance styles. Campers will have a brief showcase in Friday's closing ceremonies.

SPORTS CAMP - SWIM

Swim Sports Camp is an introduction to Competitive Swimming, Water Polo, Snorkeling, Diving, and Synchronized Swimming. Requirements for registration all campers must pass our swim test prior to registering; proof of this swim test card will need to be provided upon registration. The components of the swim test are swimmers will jump in water over their head, tread water for one minute, float on their back, and swim from the deep end to the shallow end of the pool without stopping. No doggy paddle allowed.

SPORTS CAMP - SOCCER

Develop your soccer game by working on dribbling, passing, trapping, shooting, and footwork skills, as well as concepts of offense, defense, cooperation, and teamwork.

SPORTS CAMP - BASKETBALL

Develop your basketball game by working on dribbling, passing, and shooting skills, as well as concepts of offense, defense, cooperation, and teamwork.
