TRADITIONAL CAMP – EXPLORERS

This first time camp experience for 5 and 6 year old campers will provide the traditional camp feel by engaging in both indoor & outdoor games, arts & crafts activities, and more; all revolving around the weekly theme.

TRADITIONAL CAMP – VOYAGERS/PATHFINDERS

This camp provides a traditional camp feel in the morning by engaging in both indoor & outdoor games, academic enrichment activities, swimming and more; all revolving around the weekly theme. In the Afternoon, campers will transition into “Tracks” where they participate in program specific specialties between Sports and STEAM.

TRADITIONAL CAMP – NAVIGATORS

Navigator camp offers an introduction to leadership through age-appropriate activities focused on a variety of teen interests, learning, and progressive opportunity. Pre-teens will be with campers their own age in a stimulating environment.

TRADITIONAL CAMP – LIT (LEADERS IN TRAINING)

Leaders In Training (LIT) is a unique teen camp program designed to provide opportunities to develop and sharpen leadership skills and learn about themselves through a number of fun activities and experiences.
