These trips will include camping out in a cave, ziplining, and white water rafting. Outdoor ethics will be taught to help our campers protect the outdoors for future generations.</p> <p><b>Fee: \$1,764</b></p>	<p><b>BOLD/GOLD</b></p> <p>Boys Outdoor Leadership Development/Girls Outdoor Leadership Development</p> <p>Completed 6th to 10th grades These adventures give young people the opportunity to step out of their comfort zone and explore the natural world. Participants disconnect from technology and focus on connecting to those around them and nature. This high-impact program combines thrilling adventure activities, like whitewater rafting, rock climbing, hiking, and camping. These trips also include hands-on service projects that give back to local communities. SALT is designed to build confidence, strengthen teamwork, and inspire a deeper sense of purpose through leadership in the great outdoors. Those in 9th grade can opt in for this opportunity instead of the traditional LIT program. NO INTERVIEW IS REQUIRED for SALT Trips.

### LEADER IN TRAINING (LIT)

Our Leader-In-Training (LIT) program is for those campers who are ready to take on real responsibility at camp. Their experience culminates in a three-week, immersive leadership experience. LITs live in cabins with campers and support staff throughout the day. They also help serve all meals in the dining hall, playing a critical, behind-the-scenes role in making camp run smoothly. While this experience is built around fun, it is also hard work. LITs are expected to take initiative to embody the core values of the YMCA (Caring, Honesty, Respect, and Responsibility), act as servant and humble leaders, be positive role models, and to contribute positively to the camp environment. Often called the "hands and feet" of camp, the LIT program helps teens build strong leadership skills through service, mentorship, and daily responsibility.
